<p>I would like my local Councillor to consider the following request for funding:</p> <p><i>(please continue on a separate sheet if necessary)</i></p> <p><i>We are the largest youth football club in Stevenage, with 494 playing members, of which 85 are female. The spit by ward is as follows: Bandle Hill 35, Bedwell 25, Chells 30, Great Ashby 36, Longmeadow 41, Manor 33, Martins Wood 25, Old Town 32, Pin Green 31, Roebuck 33, Shephall 25, St. Nicholas 26, Symonds Green 25, Woodfield 30. (Plus 67 players from surrounding villages etc).</i></p> <p><i>We are hoping that you will be able to help us finance our activities. We are entirely self funding and get no contribution from local authorities, football clubs or football associations. We are asking that councillors consider using £5 of their Local Community Budget for every player in their ward. There are three main reasons for this request:</i></p> <p><i>(a) Due to the economic downturn, we have been asked by many more parents to allow them to pay a reduced annual subscription</i></p> <p><i>(b) Last season 15 of our players had their subscription paid from the extended schools funding scheme which has now discontinued.</i></p> <p><i>(c) We have seen an increase in our playing membership this season of 50 players, many of whom are new to playing football. The reason for the increase appears to be the lack of opportunity to play football in schools, particularly for girls. (We have been approached by Tim Sills head of PE at Marriotts about this issue).</i></p> <p><i>Consequently we were asked to run a couple of free development sessions for players who have never played but would like to learn. We started a session for girls just before Christmas and it has been a great success and we now have 32 girls registered for our Wednesday evening coaching session at Round Diamond School. In January 2012 we started a similar session for boys, this time on a Monday evening at Nobel School and we already have a dozen players attending regularly.</i></p> <p><i>Problem is that we did not budget for these sessions and hiring all-weather facilities is very expensive, (£52 per hour at Round Diamond and £65 per hour at Nobel) and because of dark evenings, we will need to continue to use all-weather facilities through to the end of April .</i></p>
