Proposal for Broadwater Children's Centre:

- 4 Summer events over the summer holiday period
- Events to be held on the Longmeadow school site in conjunction with the Toy Library.
- Target audience - families with children aged 0-5
- Flyers to be printed and given out (through pre-schools, toddler groups etc)
- Posters to be displayed in prominent areas

Event details:

- Event will run from 12 to 2pm
- Parents/carers to bring own refreshments
- Activities available suitable for children aged 0-5
- Children remain responsibility of parent/carer – these are not drop-off sessions
