| <p>I would like my local Councillor to consider the following request for funding:</p> <p>Towards set up and development costs for newly developed crime diversion and behaviour modification programmes directed at 11-16 year olds across the Stevenage area.</p> <p>10 x 3 week courses 8 -10 (11-16 year old) young People Per course 80 - 100 young people over 12 months</p> <p>We are also developing a smaller less intense day workshops to years 6-11 students. Each day workshop is designed for up to 120 students and is based around consequences. This will involve an assembly addressed to a full year group, followed by a series of workshops.</p> <p>Below is a breakdown of set up costs which will help Pride Youth Project to expand and reach many hard to reach young people. Funds offered by local councillors will benefit on a large scale, measurable by our yearly outcomes and crime reduction in the Stevenage area.</p> | |

We have been very fortunate to have help in recent programmes in many areas such as use of premises and use of equipment, this has enabled us to grow but to expand further there are many essential items needed.

Many of the members involved have used substantial amounts of their own personal funds to create this project as well as funds raised through events but these monies are finally exhausted.

- Asdan short courses are the qualifications that are utilised by referring bodies such as the main stream schools although many are only interested in the respite aspect we offer.
- Throughout recent courses we have borrowed chairs and tables from the local community centre but to be a continually running program it would be necessary to purchase our own as the community centre will not always be able to accommodate us.
- A website will allow us to advertise in the modern day but also set up a forum for young people to use in a positive way to help one another or seek advice from staff members confidentially.
- As all of our personal and raised funds are finally at an end we need funds to produce more promotional DVDs and catalogues to distribute to referring bodies.
- A camera will be essential for the young people to record photographic evidence for their coursework.
- Pride Youth Project does not own a Laptop and printer and have been using the local library for this purpose which is not always convenient and a very high cost. A laptop is also necessary for power point presentation for the programmes and referring bodies.


