Housing Development

- We will complete and let 54 new council homes this year and 11 private sale homes
- We will start work on a further 298 new homes across a range of planned schemes
- We will secure a developer for the Kenilworth Close site, and commence work on site including the flagship older persons housing scheme
- We will continue to work with partners to enable the delivery of affordable homes
- We will look at other potential areas of affordable housing development across the town
