The Construction (Design and Management)
Regulations 2015 place specific
responsibilities on duty holders, including
clients, designers and contractors, and make
them accountable for the consideration
and management of health and safety
on construction sites. This three hour
CDM Regulations Training will guide you
through everything that you need to keep
yourself, and others, safe when it comes to
construction design and management.

TARGET GROUP

Anyone who is a key duty holder, whether they are the client, the principal contractor, the principal designer.

OUTCOMES OF THIS COURSE

- Fully understand the new CDM regulations
- Understand the roles and responsibilities within the CDM Regulation
- Gain knowledge of the documentation required under CDM.

THE STUDY TOPICS INCLUDE:

- Legal requirements as outlined within the CDM Regulations
- CDM documentation
- Integrated safety management.
- Role of key duty holders (clients, Principal Designer, Principal Contractor, other contractors)
- Overview of the general health and safety requirements for all construction sites
- Notification requirements

MANUAL HANDLING

This two hour course teaches delegates the best practices in manual handling to minimise the riks of accidents and injury. Candidates will learn how to improve their manual handling technique, how to conduct a personal risk assessment, and how to understand the risks linked with manual handling.

TARGET GROUP

Anyone who conducts regular manual handling tasks in their role.

OUTCOMES OF THIS COURSE

- Understand the correct manual handing techniques
- Knowledge of lifting injuries and how they occur
- Understanding of the Manual Handling Regulations

COST

ASBESTOS AWARENESS

This two hour course aim is to provide information on the hazards and risk associated with asbestos containing materials to those that manager premises or who work in premises whereby they may come into contact with asbestos containing materials.

TARGET GROUP

Anyone managing or working on buildings likely to contain asbestos

OUTCOMES OF THIS COURSE

- Have a basic understanding of legislative requirements
- Understand why asbestos must be managed
- Understand responsibilities

THE STUDY TOPICS INCLUDE:

- The properties of asbestos and its effects on health
- The types, uses and likely occurrence of asbestos and ACMs in buildings and plant rooms
- The general procedures to be followed to deal with an emergency
- How to avoid the risks from asbestos
- Different types of surveys and their limitations
- Local asbestos management plan
- Visual inspection of ACM's

COST

CONTROL OF NOISE AT WORK

This one hour course covers general health and workplace safety and the risks posed by noise to hearing. It looks at the duties and responsibilities outlined in the Control of Noise at Work Regulations (2005) for both employers and employees.

TARGET GROUP

Anyone who is exposed to high levels of noise at work

OUTCOMES OF THIS COURSE

- Have a basic understanding of legislative requirements
- Understand the effect of high levels of noise
- Understand responsibilities

THE STUDY TOPICS INCLUDE:

- Awareness of the Control of Noise at Work Regulations
- · Effects of Noise on the ear
- Level of noise
- Control measures
- Guidance on hearing protection

COST

COSHH AWARENESS AND ASSESSMENT

This two hour course will equip candidates with an understanding of how substances can harm health and what is required to ensure everyone works safely with substances. The course will also cover how to undertake a COSHH assessment.

TARGET GROUP

Anyone who is exposed to potentially harmful substances through their work.

OUTCOMES OF THIS COURSE

- Have a basic understanding of legislative requirements
- Understand the risks from exposure to substances
- Be able to complete a COSHH assessment

THE STUDY TOPICS INCLUDE:

- The different forms of biological and chemical agents
- Classifying substances
- Routes of entry
- Who is COSHH for?
- Control measures
- Environmental issues
- Practical risk assessments

HAND ARM VIBRATION AWARENESS

This one hour Hand-Arm Vibration
Awareness training looks at what candidates
can do to recognise and reduce exposure
to vibration at work. The training sets out
the risks and what can be done to minimise
the risk associated with long periods of
exposure to vibration.

TARGET GROUP

Anyone who is using Vibrating equipment as part of their job role.

OUTCOMES OF THIS COURSE

- Awareness of the regulation for hand arm vibration
- Understand the risks from using vibrating equipment
- Know how to control the risks from hand arm vibration

THE STUDY TOPICS INCLUDE:

- Awareness of the Control of Vibration at Work Regulations
- Effects of vibration
- How to assess vibration exposure
- Acceptable limits
- Control measures
- Guidance on reducing exposure

COST

LEGIONELLA AWARENESS

This two hour course aim is to provide information on the hazards and risks associated with legionella to those that manage premises or who undertake water hygiene management tasks.

TARGET GROUP

Anyone managing buildings containing water systems

OUTCOMES OF THIS COURSE

- Have a basic understanding of legislative requirements and how it affects schools
- Understand why water hygiene must be managed
- Understand responsibilities

THE STUDY TOPICS INCLUDE:

- Brief overview of relevant legislation
- What is legionella
- How legionella proliferates
- How it impacts on health
- Water hygiene surveys and risk assessment
- Proactive monitoring
- What to do if you have concerns

COST

NEEDLE STICKS, SHARPS AND DISEASE

The Needle sticks, Sharps and Disease training course is a two hour course that raises awareness of the dangers associated with sharp objects and handling them incorrectly. The course also covers the health risks, safe handling and disposal of sharp objects.

TARGET GROUP

Anyone who may work in environments where needlesticks or sharps could be found or could be exposed to disease which are present in open spaces.

OUTCOMES OF THIS COURSE

- Have awareness of the risks from sharps and diseases
- Understand the how to reduce risks
- Understand responsibilities

THE STUDY TOPICS INCLUDE:

- Contactable diseases and illnesses from sharp object injuries
- Preventing injury
- PPE and equipment available
- Diseases found in open spaces
- Control measures
- Risk management

COST

HOT WORKS

On completion of this two hour course, delegates will be able to use a simple Hot Work Permit, understand the legal requirements for Safe Systems of Work and Hot Work Permits and have an overview of fire safety requirements within a hot works environment.

TARGET GROUP

Anyone undertaking or having work undertaken for them that involves welding, blow torches or the generation of heat as part of the work or as a byproduct of the work being completed.

OUTCOMES OF THIS COURSE

- Understand the importance of fire prevention
- Knowledge of how fire starts
- Awareness of how to complete a hot works permit and there use

THE STUDY TOPICS INCLUDE:

- Legal requirements for safe systems of work and Hot Work permits
- Understanding and using a simple Hot Work permit and method statements
- Preparing to carry out hot work
- Precautions during and after hot work
- Understanding fire safety within a hot work environment, including how a fire starts, control methods, emergency procedures, fire risk assessment
- Safe storage of flammable products and fuel gases

COST

EVACUATION CHAIR TRAINING

This two hour course is designed to give staff the skills and knowledge to be able to use the evacuation chairs in the event of an emergency.

TARGET GROUP

Anyone with an evacuation chair in their building or property.

OUTCOMES OF THIS COURSE

- To understand when the evacuation chair is to be used
- to know how to use the evacuation chair
- to get a chance to use the evacuation chair and know what it feels like to use one
- provides confidence in using the chair

THE STUDY TOPICS INCLUDE:

- Reason to use the evacuation chair
- Limitations with the chair
- How to set up the chair
- How to get the person in and out of the chair
- Hands on experience

COST

WORKING AT HEIGHT AWARENESS TRAINING

On completion of this one hour course, delegates will have a better understanding of working at height, reasons why accidents happen and how to use the hierarchy of control when planning working at height. They will have an awareness of ladder and step ladder safety.

TARGET GROUP

Anyone planning, managing, or supervising working at height as well as those who are completing works at height.

OUTCOMES OF THIS COURSE

 To understand the importance of planning working at height, using the hierarchy of control, using competant staff using safe systems of work that they are trained in. Ensuring supervison of working at height and why / accidents can happen.

THE STUDY TOPICS INCLUDE:

- · Common factors in falls from height.
- What working at height is.
- Competance.
- The hierarchy of control.
- Safe use of ladders and step ladders.
- Unsafe working practices- how not to do it.


