CREATIVE & EVENTS BOOTCAMPS

Festival and Event Crewing | 11/08 – 22/08 – Stevenage

Two weeks – 5 days per week 10am – 4.30pm

This course introduces you to the essential skills needed to work safely, confidently and professionally behind the scenes at concerts, festivals and large-scale events.

Two weeks – 5 days a week 9am – 5pm
