# Hate Crime

**Don't tolerate it.  
Report it.**

**Support for victims of hate incidents and crimes**



## What is hate crime?

Hate Crime is a criminal offence. It is defined as subjecting a person to harassment, victimisation, intimidation or abuse because of their:

- race or ethnicity
- disability (including mental illness and learning difficulties)
- religion or belief
- sexual orientation
- gender identity
- age

Hate crime can take many forms including physical attacks, threats of attack, verbal abuse or insults. A victim does not have to be a member of the group at which the hostility is targeted. In fact, anyone could be a victim of a hate crime.

## Why should you report hate crime?

Hate crimes and incidents can be confusing and frightening for individuals and can have an impact on entire communities. By reporting them when they happen to you, you may be able to prevent these incidents from happening to someone else. If offenders are going to be punished, hate crimes must be reported to the police.

## How can I report a hate crime or incident?

Whether you have been a victim, a witness, or you are reporting on behalf of someone else, you can report a hate crime or incident by contacting the police on the non-emergency number 101. **Always dial 999 in an emergency.**



If you are deaf or speech impaired, you can report an emergency to the police by text from a mobile phone. You have to be registered to use this service. To do so, follow these easy steps:

- Text 'REGISTER' from your mobile phone to 999.
- When you receive a text message back, reply with the word 'YES'.
- You will receive a confirmation text to confirm you have registered to the service.

If you do not feel comfortable talking directly to the police, you can report an incident at a third party reporting centre. Stevenage Borough Council is a third party reporting centre and has several officers that are trained to deal with reports of hate crime. If you wish to speak to someone about a hate crime or incident, you can contact Stevenage Borough Council using the details on the back of this leaflet.

## Where can I get support?

Hertfordshire Beacon victim care centre have specially trained staff that are able to offer free practical help and emotional support. If you have been a victim of hate crime, you can speak with a member of the victim service team on 03000 115555.
