

Petition title: Connect the whole of the Great Ashby area to high-speed broadband as soon as possible

Petition details:

'Residents in the SG1 6GR are currently stuck with 1MB of broadband through their phone landlines because there are currently no (or extremely few) fibre optic cabinets on the streets to provide fibre-optic broadband. We the undersigned request that all internet cabinets in Great Ashby are upgraded to support high-speed fibre optic broadband with a speed of at least 20MB. We also request that the undersigned be provided with bi-weekly updates on the progress of the installations and upgrades.'
