DESCRIPTION OF PATH TO BE EXTINGUISHED

The full width of Stevenage Bridleway 90 from the western side of the hospital grounds at TL 2281 2668 (point A on the Order Plan) then generally east for approximately 410 metres to a junction with North Road (public highway) at TL 2319 2675 (point B on the Order Plan).




 Bridleway to be extinguished
