REASON WHY THIS DECISION DID NOT APPEAR ON THE FORWARD PLAN AND THE URGENCY PROVISIONS WERE NOT FOLLOWED:

This key decision was taken as part of the Council's emergency response to the national Coronavirus Emergency. Due to the necessary speed of decision taking at this time it was not possible to comply with the Council's Constitution that includes the requirement to give 28 days' notice of the decision to be taken; publish details 5 clear days before the decision was taken; publish the decision within 2 days of it being taken; and provide the 5 day call-in period before implementation. Nor was it possible to comply with the Urgency provisions in the Constitution

DECISION TAKEN:

The bulky waste and skip service were suspended on 24/03/20.

REASONS FOR DECISION:

- To ensure that statutory services can continue to be provided.
- Government advice on the prioritisation of waste services recommends that bulky collections and skips should be a low priority.
- To ensure a safe working environment for staff, and reduce risk of further staff depletion through exposure to contaminated material.

OTHER OPTIONS CONSIDERED AND REJECTED:

Continuation of these services was considered but rejected given the available resources. This will be kept under review as the situation with HWRCs develops.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

No significant impact identified. These services generate a small surplus.

LEGAL IMPLICATIONS:

None identified. These are non-statutory services.
