1. **Decision**

To award a concession contract for four years and grant the associated lease to the preferred operator for the operation and management of an on-water inflatable feature and other pay and play activities on the lake at Fairlands Valley Park.

2. **Reasons for the decision**

The Council received one submission from the preferred operator. Officers have subsequently evaluated the submission documentation and the applicant has passed all the required due diligence criteria to provide an inflatable play facility and pay and play activities on the lake at Fairlands Valley Park.

3. **Alternative options considered and rejected ²**

Following the ending of services provided by the previous concessionaire, the Council has engaged with the market to secure a new operator to manage the service for the 2025 season.

To not award would result on water inflatable service not being provided at Fairlands Valley Park.
