Directions for Service

2 Pursuant to CPR r 6.27 the Claimant has permission to serve the evidence by the alternative means set out at paragraphs 2(1) to 2(7) below.

(i) Issuing a media release (which may be combined with the media release referred to at Sch.3, para.1(ii) of the Final Injunction Order dated 1 February 2023).

Such release must provide:

3 The Applications, Documents and Evidence shall be deemed served on the Defendants at 23.59 on Monday 6 February 2023.

4 The Claimant shall file a witness statement (which may be combined with the witness statement required by paragraph 7 of the Final Injunction Order dated 1 February 2023) confirming that the steps taken to effect service set out at paragraph 2, within 14 days of the final step being taken. If paragraph 2 has not been fully complied with the Claimant shall identify the deficiency and provide an explanation so that a judge may consider whether to authorise retrospective alternative service, pursuant to CPR r. 6.27. The statement shall be sufficiently served by taking the step referred to at paragraph 2(3) above within 7 days of filing it with the Court.
