



THE BOROUGH OF STEVENAGE (COUNCIL HOUSING CAR PARKS) (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Stevenage Borough Council, acting as agents for the Hertfordshire County Council and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police has made the above named Order under Sections 32 to 35B and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

This Order has been made in order to allow parking in the Harrow Court Car Park to be effectively managed so as to relieve or prevent the congestion of traffic both within the car park and on the public road. This Order will come into effect on 7 March 2022.

The effect of the Order would be to make the car park subject to Civil Parking enforcement and allow the council to prevent obstructive parking and to designate parking bays within the carpark for disabled drivers, electric vehicle recharging, motorcycles, and for loading/unloading to take place.

Any person wishing to question the validity of this order or any provision contained within the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to that order, may apply to the High Court for this purpose within six weeks of the date on which the order was made 11 February 2022.
