THE BOROUGH OF STEVENAGE (PERMIT PARKING) ORDER 2018 (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Stevenage Borough Council, acting as agents for the Hertfordshire County Council and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police has made the above-named Order under Sections 45, 46, 47, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order is to extend the eligibility to the residents of 7, 7A, 11, 13, 15 and 17 North Road, Stevenage into the existing Burymead permit parking restrictions and introduce two new permit parking bays on the eastern side of North Road opposite numbers 11 and 17. The Order will come into effect on 1 March 2024.

Full details of these proposals are set out in the Order which, together with the plan and a statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order, can be examined during normal opening hours at the Council's offices in Daneshill House. Any person wishing to question the validity of any of this order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the order, may apply to the High Court for this purpose within six weeks of the date on which the order was made, **11** January 2024.
