ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE BOROUGH OF STEVENAGE (OLD TOWN, STEVENAGE) (PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2020 (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2026

The STEVENAGE BOROUGH COUNCIL (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) pursuant to arrangements made with the County Council of Hertfordshire under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Authorities (Arrangements for the Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 32, 35, 45, 46 and 46A and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9, of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as “The Borough of Stevenage (Old Town, Stevenage) (Parking Places) Order 2020 (Amendment) Order 2026” and shall come into operation on **DD MMMM 202Y**.
2. In this order:

 “The Order of 2020” means The Borough of Stevenage (Old Town, Stevenage) (Parking Places) Order 2020;

 “The Order of 2018” means the Borough of Stevenage (Permit Parking) Order 2018.
3. The Schedule of the Order of 2020 shall be amended to include the items indicated in Schedule One of this Order.
4. Schedule Two of the Order of 2018 shall be amended to include the items indicated in Schedule Two of this Order.
5. Schedule Three of the Order of 2018 shall be amended to include the items indicated in Schedule Three of this Order.
6. The provisions of The Borough of Stevenage (Control of Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017 are hereby revoked only in so far as they are affected by the provisions of this Order.
7. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

8. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any other regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
