**THE BOROUGH OF STEVENAGE (COREYS MILL LANE AND B197 NORTH ROAD, STEVENAGE) (ON STREET PAY AND DISPLAY AND PAY BY PHONE) ORDER 2016 (AMENDMENT NO 2) ORDER 2023

THE BOROUGH OF STEVENAGE (COREYS MILL LANE AND WHITNEY DRIVE, STEVENAGE)  
(RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2023**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Stevenage Borough Council, acting as agents for the Hertfordshire County Council and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police proposes to make the above-named Orders under Sections 1, 2, 3, 45, 46, 46A, 47, 49 & 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

These Orders have been proposed to maintain and improve the amenity of the area by increasing parking capacity, and to prevent hazardous and obstructive parking.

The effect of The Borough of Stevenage (Coreys Mill Lane and B197 North Road, Stevenage) (On Street Pay and Display and Pay by Phone) Order 2016 (Amendment No 2) Order 2023 would be to increase the number of parking bays in Coreys Mill Lane.

The effect of The Borough of Stevenage (Coreys Mill Lane and Whitney Drive, Stevenage) (Restrictions of Waiting) Order 2023 will be to restrict waiting at any time in the turning area of Whitney Drive adjacent to the new parking bays in Coreys Mill Lane, in order that vehicles can maneuver safely when turning.

Full details of these proposals are set out in the Orders which, together with plans and a statement of the reasons for proposing to make the Orders, can be examined during normal opening hours at the Council's offices in Daneshill House.
