## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

### THE BOROUGH OF STEVENAGE (LONDON ROAD, STEVENAGE) (DISABLED PERSON'S PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2020 (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2023

The STEVENAGE BOROUGH COUNCIL (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made with the County Council of Hertfordshire under Section 19 Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Authorities (Arrangements for the Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Borough of Stevenage (London Road, Stevenage) (Disabled Person's Parking Places) Order 2020 (Amendment) Order 2023" and shall come into operation on **DDMMMM 2023**.
2. This Order amends The Borough of Stevenage (London Road, Stevenage) (Disabled Person's Parking Places) Order 2020 as specified in the articles 3, 4 and 5 of this Order.
3. In the Order of 2020, article 3 shall be removed and there shall be inserted in their place the following Article:
  3. The area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby designated as a parking place limited to three hours waiting with no return in the next one hour for disabled person's vehicles which display in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and parking disc indicating the quarter hour period in which waiting by that vehicle began in that parking place.
4. In the Order of 2020, article 4 shall be removed and there shall be inserted in their place the following Article:
  4. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order, where in Article 3 of this Order a parking place is designated for limited to three hours waiting with no return in the next one hour for disabled person's vehicles which display in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and parking disc indicating the quarter hour period in which waiting by that vehicle began in that parking place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop or wait in that parking place unless it is:
    - (1) a disabled persons vehicle on which is displayed in the relevant

position a disabled persons badge and parking disc indicating the quarter hour period in which waiting by that vehicle began in that parking place; and

(2) parked wholly within the marked limits of the parking place.

5. In the Order of 2020, the Schedule shall be removed and there shall be inserted in their place the following Schedule:
