NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Stevenage Borough Council, acting as agents for the Hertfordshire County Council and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police proposes to make the above-named Orders under Sections 1, 2, 3, 32-35C, and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

These orders are proposed to avoid danger to persons or traffic using the road and prevent the likelihood of any such danger arising; to facilitate the passage of traffic on the road; preserve and improve the amenity of the area; and prevent and relieve the congestion of traffic.

The effects of these orders are:

- to revise the layout of disabled parking bays, pay-by-phone parking bays and no waiting, no loading parking restrictions in Marshgate to correspond with the needs of the updated street layout;
- to bring up to date the area designated as a car park in Marshgate, with appropriate rules for its management; and
- to define the charges for parking in Marshgate Car Park and update the charges for parking in Railway North Car Park as set out below.
