

Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995

Town and County Planning (General Permitted Development) (Amendment) (England) Order 2015

Notice of Direction made under Article 4 (1) of the Order

Stevenage Borough Council (“the Borough Council”) has made a Direction under Article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 2015, as amended (“the General Permitted Development Order”).

The Direction relates to development comprising the change of use of a building from a use falling within Class B1c (light industrial) of the Schedule to the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 as amended, to a use falling within Class C3 (dwelling house) of that Order and removes permitted development rights under Class PA of Part 3 to Schedule 2 of the General Permitted Development Order for this type of development from the date when the Direction comes into force.

The Article 4 Direction applies to the Employment Areas of Gunnels Wood and Pin Green. A copy of the Direction, including a map defining the areas covered, can be viewed at the Stevenage Borough Council Offices in Danestrete, Stevenage Central Library at Southgate and the Old Town Library at 38 High Street or on the Council’s website at www.stevenage.gov.uk/.
